## A member driven club with:

- 6 outdoor covered rifle benches with target frames and berms at 25, 50, 100, 200 and 300 yards.
- Large and small steel gongs at 300 yards.
- 2 enclosed shooting points on the 300 yard range for winter shooting.
- 10 outdoor covered pistol shooting points with targets out to 75 yards.
- Indoor pistol and smallbore rifle range with 7 lanes, 50'.
- A modern, indoor classroom/clubhouse for meetings and training/education.
- A walking trail for field days required by MN DNR Youth Firearms Safety certification.
- Regular monthly classes for MN Permit to Carry a Pistol certification.
- Many sponsored indoor and outdoor shooting events and competitions.
- Many sponsored educational and training events.
- Outdoor ranges are open to members from 8:00 AM until ½ hour before sunset. Always
  check the online calendar before heading to the range, to make sure the range is not

- The indoor range is open for general shooting during specific hours Monday, Wednesday and Friday during the winter. The indoor range is also used for four different shooting leagues and for scheduled training in the winter.
- The ranges are available for use by law enforcement, government qualification groups, youth groups and other entities.
- Our plans for the new outdoor site include:
  - Moving the classroom/clubhouse to the new outdoor range
  - Building a new indoor range at the new site
  - Building an outdoor smallbore range
  - Building a 1,000 yard range
